



## **Metuchen Role of Honor**

The Roll of Honor lists all Metuchen residents who served in the military during World War II. A star next to the name indicates death while in service.

Dedicated on July 3, 1942, the Roll of Honor was installed by the Mayor and Council of Metuchen, and is maintained by the Metuchen Rotary Club. The original Roll was located in the lobby of Metuchen Borough Hall from 1942 until 2001 when the building was demolished. A new Roll of Honor was subsequently installed in the new Borough Hall, and is located in the lobby across from the elevator. A duplicate of the new Roll is located outdoors in front of 351 Main Street.

In 2013, the Metuchen-Edison Historical Society photographed and transcribed the new Roll of Honor so that it could be placed on the MEHS website for all to see.
